

SA OVERSEAS GOODS EXPORTS, APRIL 2016

Summary

In the 12 months to April 2016, the value of South Australia's overseas goods exports totalled \$11.6 billion.

This was up 1.7% (\$198 million) on the previous twelve months in original terms.

Nationally, the value of overseas goods exports was down 4.9% (\$12.5 billion) in original terms over the same period.

The total value of South Australian exports continues to be supported by growth in the value of exports of 'other/ confidential' (which includes bulk barley), wine, wheat, copper and vegetables and fruit. These gains, however, were partially offset by declines in the value of exports of metal ores and metal scrap, road vehicles, parts and accessories, coal and gas and gold, silver and platinum.

Excluding minerals, petroleum and grains, South Australian exports in the year to April 2016 were up by 7.6%.

Export growth in the year to April 2016 was recorded in the export markets of Total EU, US, Canada, ASEAN (including Malaysia) but there have been declines in the major export destinations of China, India, Japan, Hong Kong and UK.

Note: Monthly estimates of merchandise exports are generally volatile and are unadjusted for seasonal factors—consequently monthly data should be treated with caution. To provide a better indication of underlying trends, the majority of data reported in this brief relate to the latest 12-month period compared to the previous 12-month period. All data are in original nominal terms, hence both quantity and price changes contribute to changes in values.

Further Analysis

Increases in the value of overseas goods exports in the year to April 2016 were recorded in Tasmania (up 13%), Queensland (up 6.5%), Victoria (up 2.1%), South Australia (up 1.7%) and New South Wales (up 0.4%) while decreases were recorded in the Northern Territory (down 26%) and Western Australia (down 14%).


In South Australia, export commodities recording growth in the year to April 2016 compared with the year to April 2015 included:


- 'other/ confidential' (which includes bulk barley) (up \$313 million or 14%);
- wine (up \$159 million or 13%);
- wheat (up \$150 million or 12%);
- copper (up \$104 million or 9.1%); and
- vegetables and fruit (up \$102 million or 22%).

During the same period, South Australian exports that recorded a decline in value included:

- metal ores and metal scrap (down \$663 million or 34%);
- road vehicles, parts and accessories (down \$53 million or 13%);
- coal and gas (down \$48 million or 66%);
- gold, silver and platinum (down \$26 million or 31%); and
- other metals (down \$21 million or 92%).


South Australian export markets that experienced growth in the year to April 2016 compared with the year to April 2015 included:

- Total EU (up \$216 million or 22%);
- US (up \$163 million or 11%);
- Canada (up \$144 million or 63%);
- ASEAN (up \$134 million or 7.1%) including Malaysia (up \$71 million or 10%); and
- Middle East (up \$18 million or 2.4%).

South Australian export markets that experienced a decline in the year to April 2016 included:

- China (down \$350 million or 14%);
- India (down \$128 million or 17%);
- Japan (down \$73 million or 13%);
- Hong Kong (down \$35 million or 13%); and
- UK (down \$24 million or 5.5%).
