LABOUR MARKET, NOVEMBER 2016

Summary

During November, total employment:

- rose 0.2% in South Australia in <u>trend</u> terms (nationally, total employment rose marginally (up by 3,100 persons)); and
- rose marginally in South Australia in seasonally adjusted terms (up by 300 persons) (nationally, total employment rose by 0.3%).

During November, the unemployment rate:

- was 6.7% in South Australia in <u>trend</u> terms (5.6% nationally); and
- was 7.0% in South Australia in <u>seasonally adjusted</u> terms (5.7% nationally).

Underemployment is above average in South Australia and as a result the overall trend labour force underutilisation rate was 16.7% in November, above the national rate of 14.2% but lower than in the previous three months (17.0%).

Further Analysis

Employment


In **trend** terms, total employment in South Australia rose by 1,200 (0.2%), and rose by a marginal 3,100 nationally in November—see Chart 1.

- In <u>South Australia</u>, full-time employment rose by 1,100 persons (0.2%) and part-time employment rose by a marginal 100.
- <u>Nationally</u>, full-time employment was flat but part-time employment rose by 3,100 (0.1%).

Annual trend employment growth was 1.2% for South Australia and 0.7% nationally.

In **seasonally adjusted** terms, total employment in <u>South Australia</u> rose marginally (up by 300 people) in November, following a rise of 0.4% in October. Employment rose by 39,100 (0.3%) <u>nationally</u>.


- In <u>South Australia</u>, full-time employment rose by 6,200 (1.2%) but part-time employment fell by 5,900 (2.0%).
- <u>Nationally</u>, full-time employment rose by 39,300 people (0.5%) while part-time employment fell marginally (down by 200).




Hours worked

In **trend** terms, monthly hours worked in all jobs rose by 0.2% in South Australia in November and was 1.2% higher than a year earlier—see Chart 2. Nationally, aggregate hours worked increased by 0.3% through the year to November.








<u>Unemployment</u>

In **trend** terms, the unemployment rate in <u>South</u> <u>Australia</u> remained unchanged at 6.7% in November. <u>Nationally</u>, the unemployment rate remained unchanged at 5.6% in November see Table 1 and Chart 4.




In **seasonally adjusted** terms, <u>South Australia's</u> unemployment rate rose from 6.5% in October to 7.0% in November. <u>Australia's</u> unemployment rate rose from 5.6% in October to 5.7% in November.



Participation

In **trend** terms, the participation rate in <u>South</u> <u>Australia</u> rose by 0.1 of a percentage point to 62.1% in November. <u>Nationally</u>, the participation rate remained unchanged at 64.5%—see Chart 5.



In **seasonally adjusted** terms, the <u>South</u> <u>Australian</u> participation rate rose to 62.3% in November from 61.9% in October. <u>Nationally</u>, the participation rate rose by 0.2 of a percentage point to 64.6%.
