Dear Minister,

As we combat the most significant health and economic crises in our state's history it is critical that we remain focussed on delivering our commitments to South Australians and developing a strong future for our state.

On our election in March 2018, we set out a Strong Plan for South Australia and Cabinet accepted collective responsibility for its delivery. I am pleased to advise that a substantial majority of our election commitments have already been delivered.

I very much appreciate the collegiate approach all my ministers have taken. Together, we have restored proper Cabinet government processes and established clear lines of accountability for the heads of government agencies to ensure Cabinet decisions and government services are delivered in a timely and efficient manner.

I reiterate my comments to you regarding the high standards of ministerial accountability that I expect.

The purpose of this letter is to identify the specific responsibilities you will have during the remainder of this term of government.

As Minister for Police, Emergency Services and Correctional Services, I expect you to deliver on the following priorities:

- Introduction of new Firearm Control System
- SAPOL's new role of promoting road safety
- Targeting dangerous road users
- Legislation to make significant changes to Graduated Licencing Scheme for motor cyclists
- Implementation of amendments to the Evidence Act to permit police to video or take audio statements from victims of domestic violence
- Upgrade of Police Communication Centre
- Development of multi-agency facility at Umawa on APY Lands to enhance SAPOL service delivery in dealing with child protection and family violence matters

- Upgrade of Yatala Labour and Adelaide Women's prisons
- Delivery of \$8 million annual operating savings from outsourcing management of Adelaide Remand Centre
- Delivery of new Emergency Services Command Centre at Keswick
- Progress the Community Transition and Learning Centre in response to continuing over-representation of Aboriginal people in the correctional system

In addition to the specific matters referred to above, I have given you responsibility for policies and programs that ensure high quality emergency services to the people of South Australia and strong police and correctional services.

Like all other ministers you will have responsibility in your portfolio areas for the development of policies to take into a second term of government, should we be re-elected at the 2022 election.

Serving our State as a member of Cabinet is both a privilege and a responsibility. I look forward to your continuing service as we build a better State and work to improve the lives all South Australians.
