As we combat the most significant health and economic crises in our state's history it is critical that we remain focussed on delivering our commitments to South Australians and developing a strong future for our state.

On our election in March 2018, we set out a Strong Plan for South Australia and Cabinet accepted collective responsibility for its delivery. I am pleased to advise that a substantial majority of our election commitments have already been delivered.

I very much appreciate the collegiate approach all my ministers have taken. Together, we have restored proper Cabinet government processes and established clear lines of accountability for the heads of government agencies to ensure Cabinet decisions and government services are delivered in a timely and efficient manner.

I reiterate the expectations I set out in my charter letter dated 23 March 2018 of high standards of ministerial accountability.

As Minister for Innovation and Skills, I expect you to deliver on the following priorities:

- Implementation of the Future Industries Exchange for Entrepreneurship Strategy and continued development of the Lot Fourteen start-up hub
- Continuing implementation of Skilling South Australia Program to ensure an additional 20,800 apprenticeships and traineeships
- Implementation of Growth State portfolio initiatives including establishment of the Australian Cyber Collaboration Centre and support for Creative Industries
- Review of the Training and Skills Development Act 2008

In addition to the specific matters referred to above, you retain responsibility for policies and programs that ensure South Australians have the skills necessary for future jobs and that industry is well supported to create those employment opportunities.

Like all other ministers you will have responsibility in your portfolio areas for the development of policies to take into a second term of government, should we be re-elected at the 2022 election.

Serving our State as a member of Cabinet is both a privilege and a responsibility. I look forward to your continuing service as we build a better State and work to improve the lives all South Australians.
