REMISSION OF FEES

The attention of Heads of Departments is directed to the attached copy of a general Direction that the Honourable the Attorney-General has given in relation to the remission of fees payable to the Crown and the free supply of copies of official documents in connection with professional work carried out by or for the Legal Services Commission of South Australia.

This instruction supersedes a direction from the former Attorney-General contained in a minute to all Ministers dated 12th February, 1979. The only alteration made is that statistical analyses performed by the Office of Crime Statistics are not to be exempt from the payment of fees.

The direction is brought to your notice as the current authority for remission of fees under the Legal Services Commission Act.

ATTACHMENT TO PREMIER'S DEPARTMENT CIRCULAR NO. 78

**LEGAL SERVICES COMMISSION ACT, 1977-1979 – REMISSION
OF FEES**

I, the Honourable Kenneth Trevor Griffin, Attorney-General for South Australia hereby make the following general direction pursuant to the provisions of Section 28 of the Legal Services Commission Act, 1977-1979.

1. Any fees that would be payable to the Crown in connection with any act, transaction or matter (other than statistical analyses performed by the Office of Crime Statistics and such other act, transaction or matter as I may direct from time to time) arising in the course of professional legal work carried out for an assisted person are hereby remitted.
2. A certified or other copy of any document in the possession, custody or control of any officer in the employment of the State is, if that copy is required in connection with any professional legal work carried out for an assisted person, to be supplied free of cost to the Commission or any legal practitioner acting for an assigned person.
3. This direction supersedes the direction made on the 12th day of February, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Section 28 of the abovementioned Act.
