Minutes

1. Welcome and apologies

- 1.1 All members present.
- 1.2 Jim McDowell attended via telephone, David Reynolds chaired the meeting
- 1.3 Dr Chris Lease, Dr Mike Cusak, Mr Mike Wait SC and AC Noel Bamford attended as guests.

2. Minutes of the previous meeting

- 2.1 Minutes of the meetings 05 June and 09 June were endorsed

3. National Cabinet update

- 3.1 CE DPC noted significant discussion at National Cabinet, which was provided immediately after the meeting to State Coordinator, Chief Public Health Officer, CE DHW and others.

- 3.2 The outcomes of the National Cabinet meeting provided further information to the State Coordinator in addition to the recommendations of the Transition Committee, and accordingly the positions announced by the State Coordinator following the National Cabinet meeting reflect the entirety of the input from both the Transition Committee and National Cabinet.
- 3.3 Following discussions at National Cabinet, it was agreed to set a date by which all quarantine requirements for domestic travellers in to South Australia would cease. This was set as 20 July.
- 3.4 The State Coordinator also agreed to seek additional advice on applying different quarantine requirements to travellers arriving from different South Australian jurisdictions. This advice has now been received (and circulated out of session to Committee members) and on this basis the State Coordinator advised the Committee of his intention to proceed to amend the Cross-Border Travel Direction consistent with the previous advice of the Transition Committee, to cease the quarantine requirement for travellers arriving directly into SA from WA, NT and Tasmania.

4. AHPPC update

- 4.1 CPHO noted that AHPPC discussions had focused on crowd and gathering numbers at Step 3, with a generally agreed limit of 500 except for stadia and other managed events.
- 4.2 Larger events could seek specific approval through SA Health on an exemption basis.
- 4.3 AHPPC recognise the density requirement is particularly disadvantageous to small venues, and will be specifically considering this issue.
- 4.4 **Action: An approach for small venues to be considered at the next meeting.**

5. Step 2 Plus (from 19 June)

- 5.1 Items 5 and 6 were combined in discussion.
- 5.2 The Committee discussed the need for further work on small venues and the density requirement for Step 3.
- 5.3 **Action: Invite Commissioner for Liquor and Gambling to the next meeting.**

6. Indoor Group Fitness Classes Limit

- 6.1 Based on discussions with industry, CPHO proposed that at a density of 1 per 4 sqm, classes of up to 10 are allowed, and at a density of 1 per 7 sqm, classes of up to 20 are allowed. The Committee agreed to recommend this approach to the State Coordinator for Step 2 Plus commencing 19 June.

7. Zoos SA

7.1 No further issues were identified for discussion.

8. Communications update

8.1 The Committee noted the paper circulated.

9. Any other business

9.1 SAPOL advised of a viral video which may give rise to further Black Lives Matter protests.

9.2 The Committee discussed whether a specific activity of public assemblies could be provided for in the direction so that it is not necessary to manage these on an exemptions basis.

9.3 The Committee agreed to recommend to the State Coordinator that the same limit that applies to other outdoor defined public activities of 300 should apply to public assemblies.
