### **4. Cross border travel**

4.1 The Committee discussed the risks and benefits of a one or two step approach to removing quarantine requirements for travellers from Victoria entering South Australia.

4.2 The Committee advised the State Coordinator to remove quarantine requirements for people arriving from Victoria from 00:01 hours on 1 December 2020.

4.3 The Committee advised the State Coordinator to make no changes to the current Melbourne airport transit requirements.

### **5. Baseline public activity restrictions**

5.1 CPHO and SAPOL provided a progress update about the development of two contract tracing check-in systems – Scan Tech and the QR code based system.

5.2 The Committee advised the State Coordinator to announce that safe check-in technology would likely be available around 20 November and vertical consumption in licensed premises can resume once the technology is available and businesses implement safe check-in practices using this technology.

5.3 The Committee had an initial discussion about a set of 'COVID-normal' baseline restrictions and agreed that a further discussion is required to finalise its advice to the State Coordinator.
