

# SA COVID-19 TRANSITION COMMITTEE

## Meeting 67: 13 January 2021

### Outcomes:

5.4	The Committee agreed to recommend to the State Coordinator that travellers from regional NSW may enter South Australia, and be required to undertake a test on days 1, 5 and 12, with no need to isolate unless symptomatic, effective 0001 hours 14 January 2021.

### Minutes

#### 1. Welcome and apologies

- 1.1 Chief Executive, Department of Trade and Investment was an apology for this meeting. All other members were present.
- 1.2 Ms Ingrid Norman, AC Noel Bamford and Mr Don Frater attended as guests.

#### 2. AHPPC update

- 2.1 CPHO provided an update on the Queensland outbreak, noting that there were now 6 people in the cluster and evidence of transmission within the hotel. Queensland are contacting 250 people who have been released from that hotel. A high degree of caution is being exercised noting that the outbreak is a variant of concern.
- 2.2 CPHO advises that existing travel requirements for people entering from Queensland should be retained.
- 2.3 CPHO provided an update on the NSW outbreak.
- 2.4 The Committee discussed whether Greater Sydney, Blue Mountains, Wollongong and Central Coast could be distinguished from regional NSW for the purposes of assessing the risk of travellers arriving into SA.
- 2.5 CPHO noted the key differences between the NSW and QLD outbreak included the endemic spread in NSW and that cases in QLD are all able to be linked together.
- 2.6 The Committee agreed to recommend to the State Coordinator that travellers from regional NSW may enter South Australia, and be required to undertake a test on days 1, 5 and 12, with no need to isolate unless symptomatic, effective 0001 hours 14 January 2021.

#### 3. Overseas arrivals

3.1 The Committee noted flights arriving tomorrow, two on Friday, and one on Saturday, consistent with the declared cap of 490 arrivals per week.

**4. Public activities**

4.1 The Committee discussed whether greater capacity in seated entertainment could be contemplated if masks were required.

4.2 Action: Secretariat to seek views on this proposal through Arts SA.

**5. Economic update**

5.1 CE DTF noted negative retail results, but that the period reported on included the Parafield lock down.
