2. Queensland case update and cross border travel

- 2.1 The CPHO provided an update on the COVID-19 situation in Queensland and NSW including the two Queensland clusters.
- 2.2 The CPHO advised to delay any decisions to lift border restrictions with Queensland until more information is available about the case situation there and in NSW.
- 2.3 The Committee advised the State Coordinator to maintain current restrictions for Queensland cross-border travel at this time.
- 2.4 The Committee agreed to meet over the weekend if there are changes in case numbers that could warrant reconsidering this position.

3. Any other business

- 3.1 The Committee discussed the requirement for masks in churches where churches are full at 100% capacity.
- 3.2 No changes were recommended to this requirement, as 75% capacity with no mask requirement is consistent with other industries including hospitality and cinemas.
