#### 1. Welcome and apologies

- 1.1 DC Linda Williams attended as A/State Coordinator. Mr Don Frater attended for CE DHW. Mr David Reynolds and Ms Leonie Muldoon were apologies. All remaining members present.
- 1.2 AC Noel Bamford, Dr Chris Lease and Ms Jane Cox attended as guests.
- 1.3 The Committee noted the emergency declaration had now been in place for 12 months with a significant amount of work done in that time.
- 1.4 The Committee noted changing circumstances and the rollout of the vaccination program.

#### 2. AHPPC Update

- 2.1 CPHO discussed AHPPC input into paper for National Cabinet about opening international borders.

#### 3. Cross Border travel update

- 3.1 The Committee discussed the risk profile in NSW and QLD and agreed to recommend to the State Coordinator that restrictions be lifted from 0001 hours 09 April for Byron Bay and 0001 hours 12 April for Brisbane if current trends continue.

#### 4. Economic update

- 4.1 This item was not discussed.

#### 5. Public activities update

- 5.1 The Committee discussed the requirement to wear masks in seated events at 100% capacity, and agreed to keep a watching brief on this issue.

- 5.2 The Committee discussed social distancing in offices, and noted that none of the activities directions applied, but that any outbreak will have implications for business continuity and work health and safety. Accordingly, employers need to assess their own risk in returning staff to workplaces where they will be closer than 1.5 m.
- 5.3 The Committee noted the CPHO would be on leave next week.
