Outcomes:

2.4	The Committee recommended to the State Coordinator that current restrictions on arrivals from Victoria ease 14 days from the last community exposure, on 30 June 2021.
2.5	The Committee recommended to the State Coordinator that restrictions to apply to Victorian arrivals include a testing requirement, no entry to high risk settings and CMP events will apply until 0001 30 July 2021.

Minutes

1. Welcome and apologies

- 1.1 Mr David Reynolds was an apology for this meeting. All other members present.
- 1.2 Dr Evan Everest, Chief Supt Stuart McLean, Dr Chris Lease and Mr Don Frater attended as guests.

2. AHPPC Update / Cross Border travel update

- 2.1 A combined discussion was held on these items.
- 2.2 CPHO provided the Committee with an update on the outbreak in Queensland, noting it was caught very early and accordingly no changes to border arrangements had been recommended.
- 2.3 CPHO provided an update on the outbreak in NSW noting it was still evolving with transmission events identified in the Bondi Westfield shopping centre.
- 2.4 CPHO advised risk from the Victorian outbreak is diminishing with new cases, but all in quarantine and no new exposure sites. Accordingly the Committee agreed to recommend restrictions on arrivals from Victoria ease 14 days from the last community exposure, on 30 June 2021.
- 2.5 Additional limits including a testing requirement, no entry to high risk settings and CMP events will apply until 0001 30 July 2021.

3. Public activities update

- 3.1 This Committee noted the Doherty Institute are undertaking modelling for National Cabinet which will be informative about the levels of public activities restrictions required at higher levels of vaccination.
