

SA COVID-19 TRANSITION COMMITTEE

Meeting 91: 4 July 2021

Outcomes:

Minutes

1. Welcome and apologies

- 1.1 All members present via Microsoft teams.
- 1.2 Dr Evan Everest, Chief Supt Stuart McLean, and Ms Jane Cox attended as guests.

2. AHPPC Update / Cross Border travel update

- 2.1 CPHO noted that there was considered to be no remaining risk from the positive case who was a FIFO worker at the Tanami mine site.
- 2.2 CPHO advised that NSW and Queensland remained active outbreaks.
- 2.3 CPHO provided an update on WA, noting that close and casual contacts had been identified and most of their test results had been received. However, to manage risk significant restrictions remain including a requirement to wear masks, 150 cap for activities, density requirement of 1 per 2 sqm and stadia at 50 per cent capacity.
- 2.4 In relation to the outbreak in NT, no local acquisition had been identified and lockdown restrictions have eased but other controls remain in place.
- 2.5 CPHO provided an updated on Victoria, noting that while restrictions remain in place in Victoria the most significant risk is their shared border with NSW, but that Victoria were limiting NSW arrivals.
- 2.6 Accordingly the Committee agreed to recommend to the State Coordinator that travellers from Victoria may enter South Australia without any restriction.
- 2.7 The Committee agreed to review travel restrictions on arrivals from the NT and WA at their next meeting.

3. Public activities update

- 3.1 The Committee noted the risk posed by the positive case from the mine site was now reduced and recommended to the State Coordinator that public activities be restored to their previous settings.
- 3.2 These include a density of 3 per 4 square metres, allowing standing consumption, dancing and singing and increasing the cap on home gatherings to 200.
